Welcome - Adam Stein

Adam said it's the last monthly meeting of the year. No regular June/July meetings.

Treasurer Report - Danielle Jones - Has a push out for band fees to be paid. Ahead roughly by \$23,000 for the year. See attached report.

Old Business / Committee Updates

Advancement Update - Noelle Callas

3/23 - 5 Star Auto Spa/Frenchies - Minimal funds raised, from Noelle

4/13 - Five Guys Spirit Night - Catherine Dodrill says no word on how much was raised during this spirit night.

Touch-A-Truck Update (event date is May 18) - Ciara Ray said there is a sign up for volunteers to help in the newsletter. Sam Kilkus will put out a signup form for the students to volunteer. There 29 vehicles currently slated to be present, including a helicopter. She said flyers need to be printed out. These will be taken to pizza places, preschools, daycares, and will be sent to school admin to go out digitally on PeachJar. The event will also include stands for ice cream and cotton candy, as well as a food truck.

Golf Tournament Update (event date is May 24) - Adam handled the update for Guy Curtis, who was unable to be present. He said the volunteer signup went out in the Tuesday, April 30, newsletter. Music event tickets are still on sale (after the golf tournament). Crosswinds will play, an auction will be held. Final call for sponsors is underway. Cosner said a lot of good sponsorships are coming in. Adam said the boosters hope to foster/nurture those connections in the future. Sponsors' swag items need to be in by May 17. Adam added that it currently looks like this will be a success for the boosters.

HundredX Status Update - Adam Stein said as of today, there are 107 signups with 2,600 feedbacks. For an estimated total of \$4,177 raised, which is 41% of the goal of \$10,000. "We can do better," Stein said. Last year brought in \$7,700 and only 6 days are left in the fundraiser. The band is getting less per review this year, at \$1.60 per review, as opposed to \$2 per brand survey in 2023.

Summer Car Wash dates - June 15 and July 20 at the Bank of Clarke at the intersection of Fairfax Pike and Double Church Road in Stephens City. Adam Stein said it's a good time for kids to reconnect, and for new members to get to know current band members.

New Business

Apple Blossom Parades - Adam Stein asked if there was anything we needed to prep? He noted that the golf cart will follow the band for kids who need it in both the Firefighters' and Grand Feature parades. Catherine Dodrill said that if kids get overheated, the first move is to unzip their uniform backs. Sam Kilkus said she will get some ice packs for kids, too.

Percussion Director Report - Scott Kittrell said drumline auditions are coming up. Weekly rehearsals (non-mandatory) will be held through summer going into band camp.

Guard Director Report - Kayla Wright said that the program is still allowing rising 8th through 12th graders to do guard with the Sherando band. She's gauging interest in 6th-7th grade guard, so this second guard might emerge in the fall. Ultimately, that's how Sherando's guard will grow, she said, with a feeder program. A new adult staff member, with a dance background and who lives in Middletown, will also start with the guard soon. who is starting soon with her. She will be present at the fall guard callout meeting on Monday, May 6. She said parents of rising James Wood, Byrd or Aylor 8th graders interested in high school guard, can contact her via email.

Band Director Report - Joel Cosner – He introduced the second student teacher of this year, who has already accepted a job in Greene County. He added that band staff presented the fall marching show concept to the students to familiarize them with the general ideas about props, music and costumes. He said some of the music still has to be finalized, but it's almost there. Cosner said the band organization is so much further ahead than just a few years ago and he's very proud of what it's accomplishing.

Adam Stein noted that appreciated that students have attended the general boosters meeting with regularity (band officer Josie Austin present at this meeting).
