

- VDOT is scheduled to put the road signs out the day before for the event.

Parking

Road to student lot will be divided with spectators on left and bus/trailers on right. The road is one way to the student lot. Everyone will exit through Sherando Park.

Buses may unload in bus circle and volunteers will be on hand to direct buses to bus circle. Buses will need to unload quickly and move to the student lot area for bus parking to avoid congestion in the bus circle and at the main entrance.
