Agenda

- Treasurer's Report
 - It was reported that we had around \$10,000 in profit from the Sherando Showcase Indoor Competition.
 - There was discussion about possible sponsorship changes for next year to include sponsor logos on our trailers.
- Approve/Deny gift card purchase for trailer drivers
 - Catherine purchased several gift cards for our trailer drivers as a thank you for helping during the indoor season. As a board, we voted to reimburse her in the amount of \$150
- Touch- A -Truck No discussion needed at this point.
- Awards Ceremony will be on May 16, 2023.
 - We discussed and agreed to change the format for this year's ceremony. The Awards Ceremony will begin at 7:00PM and then we will have a reception afterwards.
 - The Boosters will provide cake and drinks for this, and ask for families to bring other desserts/refreshments to share with those in attendance.
- Board Member Elections
 - Please encourage people to run for any position.
 - Positions with a current board member leaving are: president, secretary, treasurer, logistics, volunteer coordinator.
 - Noted that some board members are interested in other positions for next year.
 - We want to encourage everyone who is interested in being on the board to get nominated at the May 3, 2023 Booster meeting. You can be nominated by others or you can nominate yourself.
 - We want everyone to know they can be involved in this process.
 - Our school year ends before we would have a June booster meeting to announce the new board. As such, we decided that after the nominations are complete at the May 3 Booster meeting, we will send out a google form for voting in a band newsletter. Once voting is closed, votes will be counted and the new board will be announced in a subsequent newsletter.

 - Middle and High Schools will be participating, totalling about 55 students. There will also be 8 band directors and 2 guest conductors.

 - We will need parent help to serve dinner.

- Fall Planning Kayla & Joel
 - New Uniform Purchase Update
 - Money has been pooled from Boosters/School/FCPS. Boosters were responsible for around \$12,000.
 - Sample designs have been presented, and are being reviewed. There could be some final changes.
 - Current students will start uniform fitting the week of April 24 during class time.
 - Guard and new band student fitting will start in May.
 - New uniforms will be ordered by the beginning of June.
 - Field Show Announcement
 - Show theme will be released to students on Monday after spring break.
 - Fall 2023 Planning
 - Planning is about 2 months ahead of previous years at this point.
 - Kayla will have a guard clinic on April 22, 2023
 - Drum Major auditions will be on April 24. 2023
 - 2023 DMs and band leadership will be announced on April 28.
 - We are planning to allow 8th graders to participate in the fall guard.
 - We are working to get as much planned before the end of this school year, so we can have a jump on things going into next school year.
