2. Treasurer Report - Sam Kilkus

- Spent a lot of money in March from paying Disney, cutting contractor checks, etc., no need to panic, however, she said.
- The Sherando Showcase did well. It brought in \$12,136 in profit. Not bad for a day's work.
 - Sam said she thinks fewer spectators attended - the event slowed way down for the evening
 - Sam said we now know not to spend as much on concessions next year
 - Jennifer Boycourt added that she thinks there's value in bringing people into the school, and show how well we can put on a show
 - Joel Cosner said this event also educates our area about indoor percussion and guard.

- Adam said he likes that it's also a music event and brings units from around the state. It's another feather in the cap for our program. The kids also like bringing other units here. Adam also shared notes from Kayla Wright, with her thanks for volunteers, donations, and support. She keeps hearing from the Atlantic Indoor Association about how well the showcase is run. The event drew more than 1,000 performers and around 1,500 spectators/others.

6. Band Director Report - Joel Cosner

- Joel shared a percussion update from Percussion Director Scott Kittrell - a stick company is considering a partnership/sponsorship with Diamond Star Drum Sticks, through which the program could get products at a discount or free. Potentially, the company logo could be on a band trailer.
- A search process is underway for a new guard director. He and Kayla are doing outreach for this, and he's communicating with as many people as he can. The guard program is such an important part of the band program and his top priority at the moment is finding the absolute best person for our kids. He asked for any help possible in reaching out to/identifying potential color guard directors.
- Both concert and symphonic bands earned superior ratings at VBODA concert assessment. Sherando is now a 23-time honor band, and for the first time since 2004, the senior class is in all four honor band years.
- He called the Sherando Showcase absolutely incredible.
- There were lots of great results for indoor groups over the season, and he said he was so proud of how they performed at championships in Hampton – they performed their hearts out. He came away super proud.
- Hosted District Jazz yesterday, and that was great.
