## 2. Treasurer Report - Sam Kilkus

- The Safe Halloween total of \$6,007.05 is definitely higher than 2024.
- About \$375 has been received from event food vendors.
- This year's Krispy Kreme fundraiser totals were lower than last year. This year's
  fundraiser didn't have sponsors, as well. She said last year's totals were affected by
  the Disney trip, because students could use funds raised to pay for trip expenses.
  However, she noted that this year's amounts are significantly lower than 2023, as
  well.
- Recent payments have included indoor percussion expenses and property taxes for the band trailers.
