1. Welcome - Adam Stein

- Adam explained the purpose of the boosters, which is to support the band financially and with time to provide a strong sense of community. He also thanked anyone who has already helped with Amazon wish list purchases, fruit donations, time at band camp, props, etc....
- He also introduced the boosters' board members.

2. Treasurer's Report - Sam Kilkus

- Sam shared information about the budget, which anticipated income of \$96,200 and expenditures of \$108,000. She said the boosters always overestimate expenses and underestimate income. Already, the boosters are slightly under budget for band camp meals. Profit/loss statements available on the website. She also noted that marching season accounts for the greatest spending - for uniforms, equipment, meals, etc., so statements will make it look like the band's accounts are negative, but money from the previous fiscal year will be applied to handle expenses. She said if boosters have any questions, the organization is completely transparent, so if someone has questions, she encourages them to reach out and ask.
- The July car wash raised about \$500. The HundredX fundraiser raised \$4,697.

3. Old Business - Adam Stein

- Homecoming Parade Concession Updates - Jen Boycourt and Shannon Damron are co-chairing the concessions effort. Jen said there will be 6 food trucks, which will donate a portion of sales back to the boosters. People were pretty eager to take part. Adam also thanked the pair for organizing the block party for the first week of band camp.
- Band officers introduced - Josie Austin - president; Hannah Mangan, vice president. Josie said Mia Doleman is social media officer and Eliot Doeden is historian.

4. New Business - Adam Stein

- Upcoming Volunteer Needs
 - Drivers needed are needed for Tag Day, Saturday, Sept 6. Tag Day is the band's biggest fundraiser, in which adults drive groups of students to Sherando neighborhoods to ask for donations. Sam added that the more cars we have and the more students we have, the more money we make
 - Safe Halloween is Sunday, Oct 19, and a committee is needed to organize this community event in which the band transforms the school's front hallway into a haunted house. This event raises around \$4,000 to \$5,000. This event and tag day could raise a quarter of our budget.
- Fall Marching Season Logistics Overview - Justin San Agustin

- Justin said he's essentially in charge of everything that doesn't breathe - meals, props, trailers and the like. He said volunteers are needed to help with:
 - Home football games (tailgating and half-time),
 - Competitions (how to move around props)
- Adam added that it's wonderful to have parents travel to competitions to help with props on the field
- Jennifer added that a SignUp Genius will also be out there for uniform help - just to help the kids put on their uniforms correctly.
