 - HundredX starts May 18 and runs through June 9. The fundraiser costs the boosters nothing, and it can raise up to \$10,000 for the band. \$1.60 is provided to the band for each survey completed, and you can complete up to 75 surveys. More information will be shared at band orientation on May 6.
- Planning of Summer Car Wash dates - Adam

 - Likely dates would be June 13 and July 18. Sam Kilkus said she could coordinate the dates and led up one, and Shannon said she could help as well.
